Congratulations to Charles-Henri de Coussergues of the <u>Vignoble de l'Orpailleur</u> in Dunham, a pioneer of viticulture in Quebec. The vineyard planted its first vines in 1982 and it is located along the Brome-Missisquoi Wine Route, which is celebrating its 20th anniversary this year.

This category recognizes <u>Bromont Campervan</u> for deploying a powerful marketing communication campaign to promote their service offering with initiatives that stood out thanks to original concepts, relevant messages and effective communication tools.
